11PM) LATE, LATE LEARNING: REFLECT ON THE CHALLENGES OF ADAPTING TO A MINIMALISTIC LIFESTYLE FOR A NIGHT. WHAT SURPRISES YOU?

12AM) MIDNIGHT MILESTONES: WHAT ARE YOU AFRAID OF WITH SPENDING YOUR NIGHT IN A CAR? HOW CAN YOU NAVIGATE THESE FEARS?

1AM) MOONLIT MEMORY: SHARE A MEMORY THAT HIGHLIGHTS THE KINDNESS OF STRANGERS. HOW DOES IT CONNECT TO YOUR EXPERIENCE TONIGHT?
